Description

- 1) Development of a coherent framework for teacher evaluation that includes both professional practice and student growth measures;
- 2) The challenges of identifying and selecting student growth measures for use in teacher evaluations for all teachers, including those in non-tested subjects and grades;
- 3) The aggregation of multiple measures in order to make determinations about teacher effectiveness;
- 4) Communications strategies for various stakeholders;
- 5) Take-aways—do's and don'ts, issues and challenges, and ways to overcome obstacles.
